The only battleship sunk in a fleet action by either torpedo boats or destroyers was the obsolescent German pre-dreadnought SMS Pommern. She was sunk by destroyers during the night phase of the Battle of Jutland. Of these, only USS Arizona (BB) and USS Oklahoma (BB) were permanently destroyed as a result of enemy action. Several other battleships have been sunk as targets, and USS Utah (BB), demilitarized and converted into a target and training ship, was permanently destroyed at Pearl Harbor.

Ranking the greatest battleships of all time is a tad easier than ranking naval battles. Both involve comparing apples with oranges. But at least taking the measure of individual men-of-war. Your mission is to destroy the enemy fleet! Play against the computer and try to sink all of its battleships before it sinks all of yours. The first player to sink all of the opponent's ships wins.
